### Are you a Carer?

*"A carer is someone, who, without payment provides help and support to a partner, child, relative, friend or neighbour, who could not manage without their help. This could be due to age, physical or mental illness, addiction or disability"*

**Do you worry about what would happen to the person you look after if you were suddenly taken ill or had an accident?**

CERS aims to provide you with the peace of mind that in the event of an emergency, your loved one will be looked after.

#### CERS:

- Is free at the point of delivery.
- Supported by a Carers Emergency Card.
- In an emergency, can be contacted 24/7.
- Can provide up to 48 hours of support.
- Is based on an agreed Contingency Plan.
- The service covers Cheshire East.

CERS is funded by Cheshire East Council and is available to carers in the Cheshire East area
